CONDITIONS FOR ACCESSING TO THE COMPETITION AREA 6.

In the introduction, it should be noted that the AJP Europe Continental Pro takes place only through the guarantee offered by the conditions specified below:

All Athletes and Coaches are required to:

- at the time of accreditation, to present the green COVID-19 certification (EU digital COVID certificate) or negative certification of a molecular swab carried out in the 72 hours preceding the date of the event, or the negative certification of an antigenic swab carried out within 48 hours prior to the date of the event;
- to undergo an additional rapid oral-pharyngeal antigenic swab on site to search for SARS-Cov-2 antigen, the result of which must be negative, before entering the Competition Area according to the procedures and times provided for in the schedule.

For safety reasons, all Athletes and Coaches who access the Arena will not be able to have contact with other external subjects.

After having carried out the Rapid Swab, if there are any positive cases, the return home will be allowed, if they have their own means, and those who have travelled on the same vehicle will not be able to participate in the competition.

The Athlete who is positive at the check with the quick swab, before the competition, will not be able to compete and will be excluded from the bracket.

Same for the technician who follows the athlete to the warm-up and on the competition area.

Rules of conduct for all Sports Subjects:

Everyone is reminded of the obligation to comply with the following rules to avoid gatherings and dangerous situations. Particularly:

- move around the Arena, respecting the established lay-outs, the signs prepared and the instructions of the Personnel in Charge;
- always respect the safety distance of at least 1 meter;
- always wear masks (FFP2 or surgical type) correctly and systemically;
- frequently use the sanitizing solutions made available;
- access the Warm-Up area, in compliance with the instructions of the Personnel in charge, to ensure at least 9m2 per couple or 4m2 per Person;
- access the Call-Room "call" area, in compliance with the instructions of the Personnel in charge, to ensure at least 9m2 per couple;
- respectfully and punctually comply with the calls from the staff for the competition phases;
- at the end of the competition, once the result has been acquired, the Arena must be exited.

We also remind you that:

- The event will take place behind closed doors; therefore, access will be allowed only to accredited sports subjects who are negative in the rapid test with antigenic swab;
- Access to the Arena will take place after measuring the T°. In this regard, a station will be equipped with personnel in charge of T° control. People with a T°> 37.5° C will not be allowed to enter the building. In this case the subject will not be allowed access.
- Coaches, parents of minors or accompanying persons will be able to access the competition area only after having tested negative for the antigenic pad.
- The pad for athletes is free, for parents, coaches or carers it costs € 5.

Attention to all Sports Subjects

The mandatory self-certification and consent to the quick swab, as per the annexes, must be completed in all their parts and signed in original.

They must be delivered to the accreditation by the technician in charge.

7. OPERATING PROCEDURES - ACCREDITATION - WEIGHT CONTROL - COMPETITION

At the time of the accreditation operations, the Social Technician must present the following documentation, both his own and that of the Athlete:

- valid identification document;
- Covid19 green certification (or EU digital COVID certified as recognized by the European Community), alternatively for Sports Entities from countries for which such documentation is not required, the "Covid self-declaration" is required as per attachments 1 or 2;
- consent to the Quick Swab (Annex 3).

Once the documents presented have been verified, the designated match official issues a Pass which has the value of a single identity document and becomes indispensable for checking the weight of the Athletes and for accessing the subsequent competition procedures.

The Athlete and the technician enter to the Arena only after having tested negative in the test scheduled before accessing the weight control and warm-up area, according to specific times.

7.1. Check covid-19

Once the Athletes and Technicians arrive at the Arena, they must go to the COVID Center set

up by the FIJLKAM, to undergo the rapid antigenic test for the research of Covid-19, which in case of negativity will allow access to weight operations and the subsequent stages of the competition.

The technicians and athletes who will be POSITIVE must be moved to a designated area and will not be able to access the Arena.

7.2. Accreditation

Upon completion of the "Check covid-19", in compliance with procedures such as document verification, self-certification, COVID 19 certification verification, the technician will go to accreditation and will collect and deliver the PASS to the Athletes.

7.3. Weight control

Athletes, who have tested negative for the Covid-19 rapid test and are accredited, will be able to access the areas reserved for them for weight control.

At the end of the weigh-in phase, the categories in the competition will be drawn according to the pre-established.

7.4. Competition

Athletes and technicians, who tested negative in the rapid test for the search for Covid-19, will be able to access to the Arena and to the Competition Areas. Remember to always wear the competition PASS.

7.5. Podium

- They will be held on the competition field at the end of the competition.
- The distance between the athletes of at least 1 meter will be guaranteed.

ANNEX 3

DISCLOSURE RAPID SARS-COV-2 ANTIGEN TEST WITH RHINOPHARYNGAL SWAB AND INFORMED CONSENT FORM

The collection with nasopharyngeal swab is a procedure that consists in the removal of the superficial cells of the mucous membrane of the nasopharynx, using a small stick of synthetic material capable of retaining a lot of organic material. The sampling is performed in a few seconds and has a minimal invasiveness, originating, at most, an imperceptible nuisance at the point of contact. The swab undergoes the viral RNA extraction procedure. The molecular swab test is a diagnostic test to detect the presence of the virus in a precise moment, very useful for example to identify a contagious subject and immediately subject it to isolation to prevent the spread of the virus. The presence of the virus in the respiratory mucous membranes indicates replicative activity, therefore the individual is highly contagious and will have to be subjected to home quarantine by informing their general practitioner. A test on the patient's negative swab on the date of execution does not mean that the patient himself, especially if particularly exposed to the risk of infection, cannot be infected the next day.
